How the scheme works

Writing a will can be very easy, but it is something that many of us put off doing. If your family circumstances have changed recently, it is important to ensure your Will is up to date and provides for those you care about. You may have moved house, retired, got married or divorced, welcomed new children or grandchildren but without a current Will your affairs may not be dealt with in the way you would want.

From **1-14 November**, local solicitors and Will Writers across North West Surrey have generously agreed to set aside a limited number of appointments to help you make a standard Will, in return for a donation to the hospice. These appointments will be available at the participating Solicitors offices, please contact them directly for more information and to book a time slot.

Our **Make a Will** fortnight is a great opportunity to tick writing a Will off your to-do list, ensure you have provided for loved ones and at the same time support your local hospice.



The suggested minimum donation*:

Single Will: £150

Joint Wills: £250

* Please note the suggested donation amount is much lower then the commercial rate and 100% of the donation goes to Woking & Sam Beare Hospices. There is no obligation to donate, but please remember this is a fundraising initiative for charity. If your Will writing needs are more complex then the standard offered, your solicitor reserves the right to charge a top-up fee to reflect the amount of work necessary. If you wish to add a Codicil to an existing Will, please confirm this when making your appointment.

How to make your appointment

Contact your chosen firm directly from the list

Bookings should be made as early as possible to avoid disappointment.

Please quote "Woking & Sam Beare Hospices Make a Will Fortnight" when booking.

Your donation must be given to your solicitor at your first appointment, either by cheque or credit/debit card. Your solicitor will forward your donation to us. If you are unable to keep your appointment, please let your solicitor know as soon as possible so it maybe offered to someone else.
